

In support of Women's History Month, The Bonfoey Gallery will be opening *Nevertheless, She Created* on March 5, 2021, running through April 3, 2020. An all-day opening will be open to the public by appointment from 10:00am-7:00pm on Friday, March 5<sup>th</sup> and 10:00am-1:00pm on Saturday, March 6<sup>th</sup>. The show will feature the work of nine well-established, regional artists: Ryn Clarke, Kristen Cliffler, Lane Cooper, Liz Maugans, Dana Oldfather, Jenniffer Omaitz, Pat Zinsmeister Parker, Pam Pastoric, and Susan Squires.

Women's History Month was officially recognized in March of 1987 and has since been acknowledged as a national commemoration of the achievements women have made over the course of American history. It is more necessary than ever to provide support and encouragement as women continue to break boundaries.

Despite any trials and tribulations faced by women and society at large, these artists have continued to create a collection of work that expands across numerous mediums. The show will feature photography, ceramics, paintings, printmaking, and metalwork.
